## What's happening ?

Some of you may be very familiar with the Summer CEF Camps - but for those who do not yet know about these camps here is a quick guide !

The objective of the camps is to provide a safe fun environment for children and young people to grow in their faith, and interact with their peers. What differentiates C.E.F. Camps from other summer mixed activity camps is an emphasis on studying what God says in the Bible. This is more than just sitting and listening, but involves participation by way of quizzes, games, memorisation, and team competition. C.E.F. is a non-denominational organisation.



This year the program will have a fun-filled schedule as usual. Inters Camp includes some extra sports activities and this is reflected in the cost. Teens camp is the most expensive due to higher transport, accommodation, and activity costs. A detailed brochure for Teens camp will be available just after Easter. The camps are non-profit making, and are priced as low as possible. The running costs include food, accommodation, transport and activities. Even the camp leaders have to pay for the privilege of serving !

### Camp Rules

- ◆ Campers are expected to attend all activities
- ◆ Campers are not permitted to leave the camp premises
- ◆ Smoking / Alcohol / Drugs are not allowed at the camp
- ◆ Campers must remain in their rooms during the hours laid down
- ◆ At all times, the sleeping accommodation and wash areas for members of the opposite sex are out of bounds
- ◆ Fire regulations and safety rules must be strictly adhered to
- ◆ Unreasonable behaviour and failure to keep all camp rules will not be tolerated and may result in offenders being sent home
- ◆ Chewing gum is not permitted on the camp premises
- ◆ No Energy Drinks please

### Residential Camps:

For the Juniors and Inters camps at Oceanview Camp Centre you will be expected to arrange your own transport both to and from the centre in Rossnowlagh. Both of the camps commence at 5 p.m. on the Sunday, and finish at 2 p.m. on the Friday. The camp centre's address is :
